
CUBE MOSAIC REGULATIONS

HANDBOOK






General Regulations



- **Participants must know how to create mosaic designs.**
- **A total of nine cubes will be provided by organizers for all age groups.**
- **Mosaic design difficulty will be age-appropriate and standardized for all cubers within a category.**
- **Fastest participant with an accurate matching design in each age group will win podium prizes.**
- **If the total number of participants in a category is less than 10, organizers may cancel the event.**



Materials & Equipment



- **Organizers will provide all cubes required for mosaic creation.**
- **Personal cubes are strictly not allowed.**
- **Cubes must not be touched, inspected, or arranged before the timer starts.**
- **An extra cube will be provided only if a cube pops during the attempt.**
- **No additional tools like markers, guides, or reference sheets (other than the official design) are allowed.**



Conduct & Fair Play.

- **No help—verbal, physical, or gesture-based—from parents or others is permitted.**
- **Only participants are allowed inside the competition zone; parents must stay in the designated area.**
- **Silence must be maintained throughout the event.**
- **Participants must not disturb others or touch anyone else's cubes.**
- **Food or drinks are not allowed near the competition area.**



Timer Rules & Attempt Guidelines



- **Participants must report 15 minutes early for setup and instructions.**
- **Timer will begin only when participant is ready and instructed by the moderator.**
- **When finished, participants must raise their hand and keep the mosaic intact**
- **Moderators will stop the timer and check accuracy.**
- **Only one attempt is allowed—no reattempts for any reason.**
- **Maximum time allowed is 10 minutes for all categories.**



Mosaic Design Requirements

- **Mosaic must match the given design exactly, including color placement and cube orientation.**
- **If the mosaic does not match the design, the moderator may disqualify the attempt.**
- **Mosaic must remain untouched until verification is complete.**
- **If the participant stops the timer before completion, only the number of correctly aligned cubes will be counted.**



Verification & Results

- **Judges/moderators have full authority over scoring, accuracy checks, and disqualification decisions.**
- **In case of a tie, accuracy will be checked first; if still tied, the participant completing earlier in registration order may be given preference.**
- **All results declared by JCA will be final and binding.**
