




GENERAL REGULATIONS **FOR COMPETITION**

- All championships are conducted under the supervision of JCA in a transparent, child-safe, and structured environment.
 - Official communication will be shared via the registered email ID, official WhatsApp community, and JCA social media pages.
 - Every participant must carry their JCA Global Ranking ID and a photo ID (Aadhaar/School ID Card) for verification.
 - All event timings follow Indian Standard Time (IST).
 - Participants must arrive at the venue at least 15 minutes before their scheduled event time.
 - Failure to report at the solving area within the designated time may result in disqualification at the moderator's discretion.

GENERAL REGULATIONS FOR COMPETITION


- Each child must carry their own cubes and spares; the organizers will not provide cubes.
- Some cube categories may be conducted online as per the Flipbook schedule shared during registration – the same JCA ID and regulations apply.
- Every participant must be accompanied by a parent or guardian (maximum of two adults per child).
- The audience must maintain decorum – staying at least 5 feet away from the solving zone, keeping devices on silent, and avoiding flash photography or loud cheering.





PRE-HAND PREPARATIONS

Venue Readiness


- Check the venue location in advance, considering traffic conditions, to ensure timely arrival.
 - Review all competition details shared via email, WhatsApp, or the JCA website.
 - Ensure your child's JCA ID card (physical or digital) is available for verification.
 - Encourage your child to practice the event rules and timer operation before the championship day.
 - Keep cubes lubricated, stable, and in good condition; damaged or faulty cubes may not be allowed.
 - Parents should keep personal belongings safely and avoid crowding near the solving area.
 - For hybrid events, ensure your child has the required technical setup at home, following JCA's online participation guidelines.

PRE-HAND PREPARATIONS

On-Venue Guidelines


- Upon arrival, report to the Registration Desk for check-in and group allocation.
- Time slots for each event and group will be displayed at the venue and announced via loudspeakers.
- Participants should keep their solved cube ready for the first round.
- Once your group is called, submit your cube in the designated collection box with your score sheet (provided by JCA).
- Wait in the Participant Waiting Area until the runner calls your name for the attempt.





EVENT FLOW

- The runner will escort the child to the solving station, where a designated moderator or judge will be present.
- For first-time participants, the moderator will explain the solving process; children may ask questions before the first attempt.
- Once ready, the participant must clearly say “Yes, Ready.”
- The cube will be sent for a standard scramble based on the event and age group. For hybrid competitions linked with this championship, the scramble may differ slightly to maintain fairness.
- The moderator will lift the cover box, signaling the start of the 15-second inspection time.
- During inspection, the cube may be lifted but no moves are allowed.






EVENT FLOW

- Wait for the timer light to turn GREEN, then begin the solve.
 - After completion, the participant must stop the timer with both hands and not touch the cube or timer thereafter.
 - The judge will record the time; the participant must verify and sign beside their recorded result.
 - In case of any misalignment, timer malfunction, or dispute, the Super Moderator's decision is final.
 - The cube will be re-scrambled, and subsequent attempts will follow the same process.
 - After completing all attempts, participants may return to the audience area.


GENERAL RULES AT THE VENUE

- Maintain discipline and silence inside the competition area.
 - The audience must stay behind the designated boundary line, coaching or signaling during attempts is strictly prohibited.
 - Mobile phones must remain on silent mode throughout the event.
 - Flash photography, loud cheering, or recording of other participants' solves is not permitted.
 - Any unsporting conduct, unfair assistance, or interference can lead to immediate disqualification.
 - Parents or participants who repeatedly disturb judges or moderators may be asked to step outside the competition zone.

HYBRID EVENT NOTE

- Certain cube events may be conducted in a hybrid format, where specific rounds are held online and finals are held offline.
- For these rounds, participants must strictly follow the online participation regulations outlined in the JCA Online Competition Guidelines.
- The results from hybrid rounds are verified and merged into the overall championship rankings.






BACKUP & PRECAUTIONS

- In the event of any technical issue, venue delay, or unforeseen situation, the JCA team may reschedule that event or consider the best verified attempt available.
 - All issues are reviewed by the JCA Supervisory Board to ensure fair handling and transparency.
 - Participants and parents are requested to remain calm and cooperative during any delay or issue.
